PROJECT DESCRIPTION



The renovation of John B. Dey Elementary School will provide 21st Century Learning Environments within an existing structure, to provide the students with a flexible learning environment to pursue project, passion and problem-based learning objectives. The original building was built in 1955, and this project will re-use all existing exterior walls and structure as classroom, administration and Learning Commons space – totaling 67,340 SF. The 39,870 SF of new construction will house the new gymnasium and cafeteria, along with select classroom additions. The project is targeting LEED Silver certification.
