Two high performance award-winning high projects, Stone Brewing Co. and 1050 K. Street, are reviewed in depth. These projects showcase progressive site programming and execution. In addition, a recommendations guidebook and street tree study for Charlottesville, VA's Department of Public Works is examined for the latest strategies in managing the urban canopy and maintaining streetscapes.
